Cari & Goatie Case Study (Cat):

In June 2013 I noticed that Goatie had lost weight and a blood test showed hyperthyroidism. He started on Felimazole to control the additional hormone from the tumour on his thyroid gland. His weight stabilised but then began dropping again in April 2014. Another blood test showed stage 2 kidney disease which frequently goes hand in hand with hyperthyroidism. He had lost up to 75% of kidney function at this stage. He started on Renalzin Phosphate Reducer, Rubenal and a phosphorous controlled diet. This did not slow the progression of the disease and he hated the special kidney food. His creatine levels fluctuated from 281 in April to 195 in May and then jumped to 425 beginning of October. This jump moved him into the final stage of kidney disease which 90% kidney function lost. His phosphorous was also really high at 2.78 with a USG of 1.020.

The vet told me it was unlikely he would live much longer and I would lose him before the end of October. Goatie was being repeatedly sick and losing more weight. I started giving him subcutaneous fluids containing sodium lactate twice a day to help flush toxins out of his system and prevent metabolic acidosis and also a dose of Famotidine to help with stomach acid. He also had a course of antibiotics. This somewhat stabilised him but he would occasionally be sick and was not interested in eating.

My friend Caroline had been using a Pulsed Electromagnetic Field Therapy device and suggested I try it. The Magnafield unit arrived on 29th October and I immediately installed it under my bed as all my cats sleep on my bed. They also sleep on the bed periodically

throughout the day so Goatie would be receiving the treatment at least 12 out of 24 hours. He also receives a dose of Colloidal silver twice a day orally.

I have noticed that he is sick less often- in fact only four times in November. I changed his diet back to high quality with a high meat percentage using a tasteless phosphorous binder called Ipakitine. Last week I was amazed to see him pick up a cat toy and play with it. Something he has not done in a long time. He is also very interactive again with his brother, even chasing him the other day in play. He definitely has more energy and is happier in himself. It is still very early days but I am keeping fingers crossed. The fact we are in December and he is still alive is truly a blessing.
